Saturday 22nd February 10am-4pm £40pp

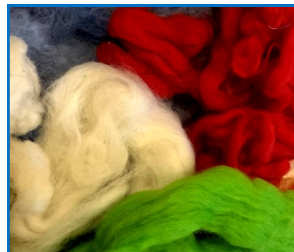

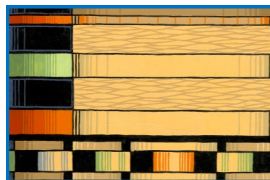

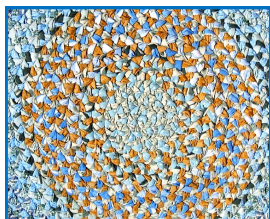
